
## A post-survey for teachers was applied to the teachers. The survey aimed at checking what did they think about the project.






## In the second item of the survey we wanted to know how innovative the project was according to the teachers. Four of them said that it was every innovative and only one claimed that it was somewhat innovative.






### What was the most enjoyable activity in the Project?

I learned about other countries, their cuisine. I also learnt new Web2 tools and eTwinning rules. Thanks to the project I know, that good cooperation is the key to success.



Has the project helped you to improve your methodological approach in teaching? 5 odpowiedzi










Had the project a positive impact on your school community? 5 odpowiedzi
















Do you think that the project's goals have been achieved? 5 odpowiedzi







## Four teachers want to join another eTwinning project in the future. One of them is not sure.




